ADVENT CALENDAR CHALLENGE!

y favourite event of Advent, as a child, was daily opening a little door on the Cadbury's Milk Chocolate Advent Calendar. The numbers on the doors reminded me how many days were left until Christmas Day. It was twenty-four days of delicious, smooth milky chocolate. However, the Advent Calendar challenge was stopping myself from opening all those tempting little boxes all at once.

As an adult I have come to realise that the season of Advent is not a time for indulging oneself with the 'best' chocolate in the world. Instead, it is a time of preparation for the coming of Jesus - not just for his first coming as a child, but also for his second coming as the Lord of lords and King of kings. Advent is traditionally a penitential season. This means it is a time to reflect on the wrong things we have done and on the right things we should have done, and then to ask for God for his forgiveness.

Advent Calendar Challenge!

Advent is also a time to get involved in a spiritual discipline or challenge. Recently, a friend of Mtr. Laurie suggested rather than twenty-four days of milky chocolate, that we read the twenty-four chapters of the Good News according to Luke. Beginning on December 1st, if we read one chapter of the gospel each evening, then by Christmas Eve we will have read an entire account of Jesus' life - and wake up on Christmas morning knowing WHO and WHY we celebrate.

NOTES FROM VESTRIES PAST

November 1957

The new Parish Hall was dedicated and Sunday School classes have been relocated to the new building from classrooms in the rectory (then located west from the church on route 20).

The wood burning stoves used to heat the structure were removed from the church as a result of the installation of its first central heating system. The stoves were stored in the carriage shed only to be stolen several months later.

It was agreed that St. Peter's chapel in Delanson would be deconsecrated and sold. That building was recently demolished by the Duanesburg Central School District.

December 1978

The proposed budget for 1979: \$14,185.

Christ Church and St. Boniface, Guilderland, agree to continue the shared rector arrangement.

A small furnace fire occurred during the Christmas Eve midnight service. The fire was quickly extinguished with little interruption of worship.

January 1980

The Vestry granted approval for a church restoration study to begin. The firm of Ryan, Biggs of Troy, NY was hired to conduct the study.



VESTRY ACCEPTS MATCHING GRANT

Building Condition Survey to be Conducted

t the November meeting, Rev. Alistair Morrison officially informed the Vestry that Christ Church Duanesburg had been awarded up to \$7,000 of a matching grant from the New York Landmark Conservancy. The Vestry, in anticipation of receiving the grant, has already received proposals from three architectural firms. After further consideration, one of the firms will be chosen to conduct a thorough study of the church building's entire structure. Recommendations will be made and prioritized on how best to proceed with structural repair, as well as, interior and exterior finishes.

Jane Weyers was responsible for writing the successful grant application with assistance from Fr. Alistair and Steve Schrade. The Vestry will select a firm to begin the survey in January or February 2020.


